## Statement regarding the RoHS Directive

Dear Sirs,

This letter serves to state our position regarding the RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU and the new version 2015/863/EU.

The RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS 2) and 2015/863/EU (RoHS 3) restrict the use of hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

The RoHS Directive regulates substances in electrical and electronic equipment. The ball screws that we produce are not classed as electrical or electronic equipment.

However, we require our suppliers to refrain from using the substances listed in the RoHS Directive in their products.

Our ball screws may feature components made of brass. This brass has a lead content (EC Number: 231-100-4, CAS No.: 7439-92-1) in an amount greater than 0.1%. Exemption 6(c) "Copper alloy containing up to 4% lead by weight" listed in Annex 3 of the RoHS Directive applies to these products.

In the event of any relevant changes relating to our products, August Steinmeyer GmbH & Co. KG will comply with its duty to inform and notify you immediately.
